## ST. MARY DRESS CODE

The dress code for St. Mary Catholic School students is intended to encourage a neat appearance consistent with our values and appropriate to a learning environment. Parents are expected to assume responsibility for making sure our students have dressed appropriately for school. Students are to be dressed for classroom work. Clothing should not distract from the learning process. Clothing should be neat, clean, and comfortable. The principal will make final decisions regarding the appropriateness of dress and grooming issues.
There are two distinct uniforms in our code: Formal Uniform and Daily Uniform. The following is the dress code for students.

Formal Uniform - Wednesday Mass Days

## Daily Uniform - M, T, Th, F <br> Dress shorts- both boys and girls

Capris
Skirts, jumpers, dresses or skorts

Shirts/blouses - boys and girls
*white, navy, light blue, or dark green
*NO stripes or patterns
*oxford, polo, mock, or turtlenecks are permissible
*must have collar and sleeves
*NO monogram or emblems unless St. Mary small emblems

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****Dress shorts may be worn from the first day of school until fall break and after spring break to the end of the school year.
$\underline{* * * * A L L}$ shirts and blouses are to be tucked in at all times.


Tennis Shoes: All students must have tennis shoes for gym class. They should be kept in their lockers for gym class if they do not wear them to school.

## NO tattoos *NO make-up *Girls ONLY/small earrings - NO other body piercing

- Modest hairstyles with no "unnatural" hair coloring or accessories permitted, i.e. pink, purple, blue, green, feathers, etc.
- Boys' hair should be above their collar, above the ears, and out of eyes. No mohawks are allowed.
- Coats and sweaters or light jackets must be worn outside the building as dictated by weather conditions. Students not having appropriate outdoor clothing for recess will be required to stay in at recess. This includes hats and gloves when needed.
- We do have a Uniform Closet that has several pieces of uniform clothing available at no cost. Use what you can and return those items when finished and get the next size needed. If you have any uniform clothing that no longer fits your child, please send those to school for another child to use.


## DISCIPLINE/CONSEQUENCES for Dress Code violations:

Frequent disregard of the uniform policy will result in communication with the parents and consequences for the student.

The dress code will be enforced. All uniform policies are acceptable or non-acceptable under the discretion of the school administrator. Exception to the uniform code will be permitted only with advance approval of the school administrator.
